

FOR ALL REGISTERED VOTERS: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

In 2024 there will be partisan primary elections.

- The Democratic Party will have a Presidential Primary Election on March 5, 2024.
- The Republican Party has chosen to hold a Presidential Preference Poll in conjunction with their statewide caucus meetings on March 5, 2024.
- According to State Law, political parties set rules regarding who may participate in their primary elections and caucuses.
- Your party affiliation will determine which ballot you receive and which primary or caucus you
 may participate in. Your party affiliation cannot be changed after Tuesday, January 9, 2024 at 5
 pm. and will remain in effect through the June 2024 Primary Election. It will also remain in
 effect

thereafter unless you choose to change it.

- You may remain unaffiliated past this deadline and affiliate with your chosen party at any time.
- If you are an unaffiliated voter and would like a ballot for the democratic primary in March, please notify our office by phone or email.
- If you would like to participate in the Republican caucus, please update your voter registration at voter.utah.gov.
